STATEMENT OF PRINCIPAL

The Equine Canada Federation (EC), the national federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction. The EC is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that owners, trainers, exhibitors and their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation, and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices.
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
- Reviewing, revising, and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibiting procedures, would determine to be cruel, abusive nor inhumane.

The Region 17 Pre Show (Bronze) & Region 17 Championship (Silver) competitions are sanctioned competition members of Equine Canada (2685 Queensview Drive, Suite 100, Ottawa, ON K2B 8K2) and are governed by the Rules of EC.

THE RULE BOOK

Exhibitors, Judges, and Show Officials are responsible for knowledge of the Rules. Both a complete knowledge of and compliance with the rules are essential, and all participants must be fully cognizant of all rules as well as class specifications in the division in which they compete. Full details of Horse Show operation - EC (including FEI) rules - list of recognized Judges - other vital information is in the RULE BOOK copyright for exclusive use of recognized shows. See current EC Rules and Amendments. Every individual is eligible to count points won at recognized EC Shows for Annual and Provincial Championship Awards. The current EC Rules and Amendments are presently in effect and have been used to compile the Rules and Regulations for this prize list. Passports are NOT required in a recognized "Breed" competition.

Amateur Competitors: All seniors competing in EC amateur classes must possess a current amateur card. This must be applied for at the same time as the "Competitive License".

Membership to EC is now called a "Competitive License". All exhibitors, owners, trainers, riders, drivers, handlers **must** join EC with a competitive license to be able to compete in any EC sanctioned show.

Permanent upgrade must be done directly through the EC Office.

General Rules

1. All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Arabian Horse Association, the Equine Canada Federation the Region 17 Arabian Horse Association, and The Region 17 Championship Horse Show, its officers, contract personnel or volunteers or any of its affiliates, the Westerner Exposition, their officers, officials and employees will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any exhibitor, his or her agent or employee, or to any horse or any article of any kind. The exhibitor will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury, to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify all parties listed above against any and all loss, damages, or liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of any entry form to the Entry Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.
2. Upon any act of discourtesy or disobedience to **any** official or volunteer of the Region 17 Championship Horse Show on the part of any owner, groom, rider, driver, or handler may result in the immediate removal from the show of said person, at the discretion of the Show Commission and the owner will forfeit their entry fees. Such action will be reported to EC and AHA for disciplinary action. Official protests (\$100 cash fee) will be filed as per the EC Rule Book A1206.
3. The Show Commission reserves for itself the power to remove any person or horse from the show without being liable for compensation.
4. The Show Commission reserves the right to add to, amend, or decide any point not covered by the rules and to correct any error or make necessary alterations in the prize list and program.
5. Patterns and Orders of Go will be posted at least one hour prior to the class.
6. The Show Commission reserves the right to cancel any class with less than three (3) horses entered. *Exception-* designated Sweepstakes, Dressage, and Jackpot Classes.
7. Potentially large classes have been split by the Show Commission and are listed as such in the Tentative Schedule as Section A and Section B with the FINAL scheduled on another day. If there are not enough entries to fill both sections then the class will be run only once as a complete class in the FINAL time slot. If there is a large class to be split it could be run back to back.
8. **Scoring System is MOS** – Majority of Opinion System – See Current AHA Handbook – This system will be used for Region 17 Championship Classes. **All AHA approved shows will use the new halter scoring system for Breeding & In-Hand Arabian & Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian halter classes as outlined in the 2010 AHA handbook .** *Specialty Classes will be scored using the one judge system as indicated in the AHA Handbook.*
9. No horse shall remain on the grounds if it is not entered in the pre-show or the Region 17 Show unless written permission is granted by Show Commission - *exception Mare with foals at side.*
10. Stallions are permitted in Junior Exhibitor Performance classes.
No Stallions are permitted in Junior Showmanship, Walk – Trot/Jog and Lead Line classes.
11. **SELECT ATR Classes open to riders that have not won any of the following:**
approved by ECF and AHA (see EC rules Arabian section B1502.6 for further clarification)
 1. AHA Regional Top Five or better in the corresponding class or any open class in the respective division.
 2. AHA National Top Ten or better in the corresponding class or any open class in the respective section.
 3. Two AHA Regional Top Five Awards or higher in a corresponding **Select** class.
 4. An AHA National Top Ten or higher award in a corresponding **Select** class.

Riders of Arabian, Half-Arabian or Anglo Arabian horses competing in the same section shall not be considered separately. If a rider is eligible to compete as a **Select** rider in a respective section on December 1, said eligibility remains throughout the competition year.
12. **Sport Horse In Hand** Classes will use Pattern “A”, the Triangle. (Refer to EC Article B2405.1/USEF 1649E1.1)
13. **Warm-up rounds** – limited to one round per horse per class with a maximum of 3 minutes in total per rider. – fee \$5.00. Time is limited for Warm-up Rounds. Time slots will be filled on a first come first serve basis.
Enter Class #900 for Warm-up round on entry form – must enter – no tickets will be sold at the gate.
14. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book. (EC Article A602)
15. **Lead Line - 1. Safety is the main priority 2. Child must wear a helmet 3. The lead line must be attached to the cavesson/halter and not to the bridle bit. 4. Saddle must fit child 5. Person leading horse must be 14yrs or older**

Horses Qualified PRIOR to June 28, 2010

Any horse qualified prior to **June 28, 2010 must** have their entries **postmarked by June 28, 2010**. If the entry is postmarked after **June 28, 2010** it will be considered a **Late Entry** & will only be accepted with **Double Entry Fee** up to **10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 28, 2010**. (This includes entries that are sent via courier service)

Horses Qualified AFTER June 28, 2010 –

All horses qualifying after **June 28, 2010 – need to provide “written verification”** of said qualification from the Show Secretary of the qualifying show. It is ultimately the responsibility of the person signing the Qualification Report to know the qualifications are correct and true. (See AHA Handbook Article 1234.1)

Horses qualifying at the Region 17 PreShow MUST enter the Region 17 Championship Show within one hour after the last class of the PreShow. No entries will be accepted after Tuesday, August 3, 2010 at 7:00 pm. Please use reason and common sense as your guideline.

Courtesy Late Fee

*****Any entry after 7:00 pm Tuesday, August 3, 2010, may be allowed to enter a Region 17 Championship class at the discretion of the Region 17 Show Commission with an additional Courtesy Fee of \$200.00 per class over & above the class fee and all other fees.*****

3. CANCELLATION OF ENTRY

Exhibitors canceling entries after **June 28 , 2010** shall forfeit **ALL** fees.

Refunds will be considered upon receipt of a suitable veterinarian certificate attesting to the illness or injury within **seven (7) days** after the occurrence of the said illness or injury & received by the show secretary prior to **10:00 A.M. Tuesday, August 3, 2010**. All granted refunds will be sent by mail after the close of the Region 17 show and will be made payable to the owner of the horse.

There will be NO REFUND of stall fees for any reason after June 28, 2010 unless the Show Commission has cause to resell it. However, if there is another horse owned by; trained by; or exhibited by the same person as the Vet Out horse then that horse will be able to use the vet out stall by paying only one (1) grounds fee.

A Vet out processing fee of \$25.00 per horse, the office fee & number fee will be retained on all refunded entries.

4. COMPLETION OF ENTRY

- ✓ All horses must be entered in the proper class and must be entered in the name of their bonafide owner or lessee as per the registration papers. Copy of the registered lease agreement must accompany entries for leased horse.
- ✓ ****IMPORTANT** ENTRY FORM. Signatures are required on the back of the entry form NOT on the front. Minor (under 18yrs of age) signatures are **NOT allowed and must have a Parent/Guardian signature on all required signature lines.** Please read the form carefully and fill in ALL blanks. Complete address information for each rider, handler, owner & trainer is also **“important”**.**
- ✓ **No more than one owner per entry form.**

✓ Entries accompanied with a postdated cheque will be processed on **that** date. If this date is after the closing date of entries, the entry will be considered a late entry and the double fee must be paid.

Qualifying information must be recorded on the enclosed form. **Exact** and **detailed** information regarding the qualification of each horse is very important as specified in the AHA handbook. Art. 1202.

- ✓ **Please list correct name of horse show, class number and class title. If qualification cannot be verified, the entry may be considered void. Your diligence in this matter is imperative. Horses must be two years or over at the time of qualifying.**
 - ✓ *Refer to AHA Article 1234.1. It is the responsibility of the person(s) signing the Entry Form to verify that the horse is eligible to be entered and compete in the respective Regional Championship class.*
 - ✓ *AHA Competition membership and Regional Qualifications are required for Regional Championship classes. A single event membership at a Regional Show is NOT Allowed. Affidavits are NOT allowed at any AHA approved show so membership will be required for the Pre-Show as well. A single event membership of \$35.00 US or \$40.00 CDN can be purchased for the Pre-show if the entry does not enter the Regional show.*
 - ✓ *Collect calls will be made to exhibitors/owners by the Entry Secretary if it is deemed necessary to clarify any information on the entry form or stabling form.*
 - ✓ *The Show Commission reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries of any exhibitor/owner as stated in the EC Rule Book (A805).*
5. **ELIGIBILITY** All horses entered must be registered with the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry, the Arabian Horse Registry of America, the Arabian Horse Association, or the Canadian Partbred Arabian Registry.

Geldings must be show as “Gelding” on the registration papers or entries will be considered incorrect. The only exception will be horses recently gelded whose papers have not yet been returned with the correction. A suitable veterinarian statement should be available if requested.

6. **RETURNED ITEMS** Upon receipt of a returned cheque for non-sufficient funds a \$50.00 charge will be levied if paid within 30 days. After 30 days a \$100.00 charge will be levied. If after 45 days the returned cheque has not been replaced, the Show Commission has the option to report the **payee to AHA and EC for suspension** and/or to impose further action for future shows. All corrected payments and charges will be accepted by certified cheque, money order, cash or credit card.

A \$25.00 fee CDN will be charged for each class each entry. No sponsorship is necessary.

Barn Calls & Gate Holds

Barn calls are a courtesy only.

Exhibitors must ascertain when and where classes are being judged. Every effort will be made to advise the exhibitor of any changes in the Tentative Schedule.

Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the public address system and paddock calls over that system must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that their horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. Every effort will be made to maintain a working public address system to carry class calls, however no protest will be upheld, nor will any section or class be changed on the basis of the public address system malfunctions.

Exhibitors are responsible for reporting all entries to the Gate attendant before each respective class is called for showing and must enter the ring promptly when called. Remember the Gate attendant cannot see you, therefore it is important that you listen carefully and report immediately to the hitching ring when your class is called.

Two Minute Gate: In collective classes, the gate will close **two (2) minutes** after the first horse enters the ring or in large classes taking more than two minutes the gate will be closed at the completion of the final horse in a continuous string of horses entering the ring - After gate is closed no entry will be allowed in unless approved by the Judge or Steward. **No exceptions.** ECF B1305.8.

In single event classes, such as reining, the gate is will close within **one (1) minute** of that individual rider being called to the ring in the order that is posted on the Order of Go. No entry shall go out of order unless approved by the Show Office.

All gate holds MUST be registered and approved at the Show Office.

Golf Carts

Golf Carts will be available for use at the Region 17 show.

2. **STABLING FORM** *Please complete the enclosed stabling form*
 Stabling for the Region 17 Pre-Show will **NOT** be separate from the Region 17 Championship Show entries. **All stabling will be requested on ONE form.** Those wishing to stable together are asked to please complete **ONE form** and send that form **with all entries in the same envelope.**
 Horses must be entered in either the Pre-Show or the Region 17 Championship Show at the time the stabling request is made. Any horse entering in just the Region 17 Championship show **MUST** pay for regular stabling. Indicate the EXACT number of Box Stalls and Tack Rooms. If the show is overbooked, the Show Commission reserves the right to use tack rooms for stalls.
3. **STABLING INFORMATION** Exhibitors WILL NOT move from their assigned stalls without permission from the Stabling Manager. Violation of this rule could result in the exhibitor and their horses being excused from the show grounds for the balance of the show without refund of entry fees.

Absolutely NO blocking of aisles. The barns are a “Public Area” and easy, clear and safe access must be provided. It is mandatory that stabling areas be kept clean.
For safety reasons, NO grooming of horses is allowed in the barn aisles.

4. **GROUND'S FEE** SHOWING out of horse trailers is permitted, however there will be a **\$75.00 plus 5% GST** = a total of **\$78.75** grounds fee charged per day. This fee will be automatically charged to each entry that does not order and pay for a stall. If this entry is entered in classes on more than one day, then this fee will be charged for each day of classes or a stall will be assigned if it is over the fee of \$175.00 plus GST.

Manure/shavings on pavement must be cleaned up or an environmental fee will be charged to the entry.

5. **BEDDING** **Shavings will be supplied however **due to the short supply of shavings**, exhibitors are requested to limit their use of shavings to a **minimum. NO shavings in the aisle ways of the barns/tents.** Keep the shavings in stalls. Prior to vacating the grounds, exhibitors are asked to remove the soiled shavings from each stall to a designated disposal area. This will assist Westerner & Region 17 in minimizing costs of clean-up & disposal. The Show Commission thanks you for your cooperation.
Bobcats or units with a Front End Loader will not be allowed on the grounds for use in the bedding or cleaning of any stalls unless pre-approved by the Stabling Manger. Misuse and/or Overuse of Shavings will NOT be tolerated. All stalls will be periodically checked by the Stabling Manager.

A \$25.00 Environmental Fee will be charged for manure disposal.

Tack Rooms MUST be cleaned out as Region 17 is charged for each tack room clean-up. If the Region 17 Show is charged for any tack room clean-up, that fee will be passed on to the trainer, owner or exhibitor whichever is applicable. Please insure that all garbage, string, twine, nails etc. is removed. – Any damages to stalls, walls, doors or any part of the “facility” by any exhibitor, trainer or owner the cost to repair will be billed to one of those parties.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

1. GENERAL

Membership in AHA (Chapter 7 in Current AHA Handbook) and EC/USEF is required for **all** riders, drivers, owners, lessees, agents or trainers and handlers (see EC Article B1302.2 page 34 2004 EC Rule Book). *Exception: Owners that are listed on the registration papers as “and” or “and/or”, for show purposes, only one owner is required to be a member.*

2. ASSOCIATE for Breed Shows Only -

This membership category is no longer available through Equine Canada. ALL exhibitors, owners, trainers MUST possess a 2010 Provincial membership in the participating PSO's (**see note below**) and a 2010 “Silver” Competition License from Equine Canada to compete in this Region 17 Championship Show.

NOTE: There has been a change in the Provincial membership status for some provinces. Contact your provincial office for clarification or check the 2010 EC Membership rule changes.

3. AMATEUR

All exhibitors showing in AAOTR and AAOH classes or exhibitors over the age of 18 years as of December 1st showing in AOTR and AOH classes **must** have a current Amateur card from EC/USEF The Amateur Status must be applied for separately from an individual competitive license and is not automatic.

Note: An Amateur may NOT show a horse that is a client of any member of their immediate family unless they are a Junior (under the age of 18 as of December 31).

4. FARM, SYNDICATE OR BUSINESS

Horses registered in the ownership of a Farm, Syndicate or Business **must** have an AHA Business Membership and EC/USEF Farm Certificate (see EC Rulebook for exact Canadian rule) AHA Business Membership must be purchased directly from AHA (Article 701.6). A Business MUST provide documentation showing the owners of that business for owner classes.

5. AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIPS are allowed at the preshow but are **NOT** allowed at a Regional or National Championship shows. AHA Membership affidavits **WILL NOT** be accepted for verification of membership at any AHA recognized show. **If you do NOT have a valid current membership card then you will have to purchase a AHA competitive membership at the Region 17 Championship Show to participate in this show.**

AHA **Single event memberships are available for the PreShow only at a fee of \$35.00 U.S.funds (\$40.00 CDN).**

See AHA Chapter 7. Article 705 See New EC Rules regarding membership.

STRESS

Horse shall not be punished unnecessarily or severely anywhere on the show grounds. A committee has been established to patrol the show grounds and abuse will be dealt with under the EC/AHA rules.

Any horse entered in any class at a competition may, while on the competition grounds, be selected for equine medication control testing. (EC Article 602.5) By entering the show all owners agree to testing for their horse(s) if selected for one. A charge of **\$5.00** per eligible horse will be made and is included on the entry form.

**EC statement – Any horse entered in any class at a competition subject to the requirement to pay drug testing fees may, while on the competition grounds and on the recommendation of the chairman of the provincial Equine Medication Control Committee or the chairman's appointee, be selected for equine medication control testing.*

All horses artificially, improperly or unfairly prepared or tampered with before coming into the show arena will be disqualified. The use of any substance to induce temporary heat will not be allowed.

If it is ascertained that an exhibitor has made, or caused to be made, any false statements in regards to any animal or article exhibited or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the judge in performance of his/her duties, they shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting.

In Hand/Breeding Classes - In the Ring Class Procedure – Judging begins when the first horse enters the ring and its movement is being evaluated and scored. The horse shall enter at a trot.

In order to lessen stress on In Hand horses, grooms will be requested to leave the hitching ring prior to the entry of each halter class. **There will be NO form of hazing, flapping of towels, rattling of cans or bottles, and chasing of horses into the ring.**

ALL In hand horses are required enter their halter class in the assigned, posted order of oldest to youngest

RING PROCEDURES

- Grooms, attendants and headers are to appear in the ring neat, clean & suitably attired, in the opinion of the Show Commission i.e. clean, unmarked smock.
- No person other than the officials, steward, attendants on duty, and the judge of the class may enter the show ring without permission from the call judge.
- No whips over six feet long, including the snapper, may be used either inside or outside the ring by the handler or assistant when showing a horse, Except in harness classes. Lashes or appendages of any kind are prohibited.
- In-Hand classes: Small appendages (no more than 12 inches in length) of ribbon, plastic, etc. are permitted (EC 1401.4)
- Any exhibitor using the wrong number or having no number *may* be excused or disqualified from the class at the discretion of the call judge.
 - **Breeding & In-Hand** classes - **ALL entries** will enter in the order posted by AGE (oldest to youngest).
 - **Region 17 will use the "In Ring" procedure for the in hand classes.**
 - Sport Horse In-Hand will use the Triangle pattern.

QUALIFICATIONS

Qualifications are good for the current and preceding competition calendar year.

Point System (Motion 21-8/14/04 BOD) Qualifications are points acquired from approved AHA shows. Please refer to the current AHA Handbook for the number of points required for each class.

New 2010 - a 1st or 2nd place Ribbon in any approved AHA show in that region will also qualify an entry – beginning with 2010 shows. A 2009 - 1st or 2nd placing DOES NOT qualify for a 2010 Regional Show.

Qualifications can be verified on the AHA website at www.arabianhorses.org

Junior Horses MAY enter any/all classes for which they are qualified at Regional and National shows.

*******QUALIFICATION REPORT*******

Qualification Report is MANDATORY for every horse and must be sent with your entry into the Region 17 Championship Show. If the AHA show record is used then the applicable Region 17 Class number MUST be written on that show record for proof of qualification for that class. The Number of Points acquired needs to be easily recognized for each class.

THIS IS YOUR DECLARATION!

Awards

Refer to current AHA Handbook:

A Champion and Reserve Champion plus three additional unranked awards shall be presented in each Regional Class to make a Top Five.

Champion & Reserve Champion trophies will be awarded in all Region 17 Championship classes of three entries or more.

***Full Top Five Awards will be given IN ALL CLASSES regardless of how many entries are competing at the close of the gate to the maximum of FIVE.**

Top Five Plaques will be given to all Junior Classes (17 years and Under).

NO Champion or Reserve Champion trophies will be given out in any of the Jackpot classes.

Sweepstakes payout and points in the Horse Achievement Award, Amateur Achievement Award, High Point Horse Achievement Award and High Point Amateur Achievement Award will be given to those horses enrolled in these programs equal to 50% of the class rounded-up not to exceed five of those competing at the closing of the gate at the beginning of the class for all classes ridden as a group and all those who pass through the gate in individual activity classes.

Top Ten, Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded in the AHA Sweepstakes classes for Arabian, Half Arabian/Anglo Arabian Yearlings. Cheques and ribbons for Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded in the AHA Sweepstakes classes for Arabian, HA/AA Yearlings and Two Year Old Arabian Geldings. Cheques will be mailed within 60 days of the show by the Arabian Horse Association.

This Region 17 Championship show chooses the option of using one ride to run the 2010 Regional Championship dressage classes. Dressage rides may be limited.

QUALIFICATIONS - Refer to current AHA Handbook – Articles 1241.3 – 1241.6

In addition to points obtained from Class A approved AHA shows as listed in the AHA Standard Class List qualifying scores may be obtained at an AHA recognized show.

Scores from open shows may be used but the horse must be enrolled and qualifying scores must be properly reported. For further information or clarification please refer to Chapter 14 of the current AHA Handbook Article 1401

2. **WORKING HUNTER** Refer to current AHA Handbook & EC Rules Article B2205

Schooling Rounds - Warm-up Hunter - is NOT an AHA qualifying class but simply "Hunter Schooling Rounds". Fences to be set to accommodate the AOTR Hunter over Fence class with heights not to exceed 2'9" and spreads not to exceed the width of the fence. This warm-up time is not run as per EC Arabian Warm-up Hunter Rules. Rounds are NOT judged. Limited to one round per horse per rider with a maximum of 3 minutes in total per round.

A \$5.00 charge per schooling round will be charged. The Regional Show Commission will accommodate as many rounds as the time will permit but limited to 1 round per horse per rider. Please enter the warm-up rounds on the entry form under class #900. There will be an order of go posted before the class runs.

Regional Working Hunter Classes shall consist of two (2) sections over fences followed by one section under saddle. All three sections make one complete class.

All horses are allowed to jump in both Over Fences Sections, however they are not required to jump in both sections.

In each of these sections the judge will place five horses 1st to 5th. Scores will be assigned to these places as follows:

1st = 20 points, 2nds = 16 points, 3rd = 14 points, 4th = 12 points, 5th = 10points.

Top 5 or 50% of the placing horses plus two reserve horses shall be jogged in (*numerical order*), dismounted and judged for soundness following each Over Fences Section. Only Top 5 or 50% of the placing horses from each Over Fences Section will receive a semi-finalist ribbon at the end of each section and will advance to the Under Saddle Section.

Regional Champion and Regional Reserve Champion will be selected from the four horses having acquired the most points in the two Over Fences Sections based on the total points earned in all three sections.

Ties will be resolved by using the sum of points acquired in the two Over Fences Sections. If a tie persists the Judge will break the tie without re-working.

3. **JUMPER** Refer to current AHA Handbook & EC Rule Article #B2101

Regional Championship Jumper classes will be judged in accordance with either USEF JP144.3 (a) Table II, Sec. 2 (a) or USEF JP144.3 (d). Table II, Sec. 2 (d) - Time first jump-off with designated number of competitors to Jump-off and the equivalent EC/FEI Article 238.2 Competitions Against the Clock.

Jump order of 1st go round will be random selection. Jump Off order is earned by the time taken to complete the course in the first go-round - the fastest time will jump last in the jump off.

If horses are still tied for the Regional Champion after the first go-round and first jump-off, there will be a second jump-off over a raised, changed or shortened course. Time will decide any equality of faults.

3. To receive a medal in this class three competitors with proper appointments must compete. see below
4. Protective headgear secured with a safety harness is recommended and may be worn without penalty.

AHA REINING SEAT MEDAL

- a. All contestants are required to perform a Reining pattern as outlined in USEF Reining, or EC equivalent. (Res 25-06)
- b. Order go will be done by draw.
- c. Bits must be dropped and inspected by the Judge or designated official, and all rider must dismount for this inspection. If called for in the ring, assistance if necessary may be had from one of the ring officials.
- d. Reins shall not be removed from the horse's neck while inspecting bits.

2. Following the rail work, two or more individual tests from E.C
3. Approved helmet must be worn in this class

1. Open to juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1st.
2. Following the rail work, two or more individual tests, from E.C
3. Protective headgear secured with a safety harness is recommended and may be worn without penalty.

REGION 17 REINING SEAT CHAMPIONSHIP

- a. All contestants are required to perform a Reining pattern as outlined in USEF Reining, or EC equivalent. (Res 25-06)
- b. Order go will be done by draw.
- c. Bits must be dropped and inspected by the Judge or designated official, and all rider must dismount for this inspection. If called for in the ring, assistance if necessary may be had from one of the ring officials.

BORDER CROSSING

Regulations at border crossings do change periodically. Always check well in advance so that on arrival, you will have all the necessary certificates, forms and information available.

There is no duty or sales tax on horses entering either the U.S.A. or Canada.

Veterinarians are usually on duty from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday. Check the border crossing for exact times as there could be a charge when crossing outside of these hours.

You must call ahead at least 24 hours to make an appointment for border crossing with horses. Many crossings are **NOT** open on weekends or after hours for livestock traffic. Establish this information well ahead of arrival to avoid long delays.

Border Crossing into and out of Canada require proof of U.S. Citizenship with a passport with raised seal.

IN ADDITION PLEASE ALSO NOTE:

For Canadian horses returning to Canada on a Canadian health certificate, a supplemental certification document with the above mentioned requirements will be provided by the CFIA endorsing office when advised of intended return. The supplemental certification will need to be attached to the Canadian health certificate after completion and endorsed by USDA before return of the horse(s) to Canada.

Make sure you contact your Border crossing destination before you leave home

Protective Headgear

Article A905.1 which states a) Junior competitors must wear proper fitting, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured, at all times while mounted on competition or event grounds.

Approved headgear meets the ASTM (American Society for testing Materials) standards and displays the SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) seal. The British standard, BSI, is also acceptable.

Article A905.2 states – It is strongly recommended that all persons wear ASTM/SEI or BSI approved headgear at all times while mounted or driving cross country or marathon.

Article A802.6 states – All entry forms at competitions that are subject to the new junior headgear rule must include the following acknowledgement and ensure that the entry form is signed by the parent/guardian. (please refer to EC Waiver portion of the Entry Form)

Directly from EC – “Is approved headgear compulsory for ALL junior exhibitors? At present, if the junior is competing in a discipline or breed whose rules specify other headgear (e.g. western hats, derbies etc) those rules supersede the new rule. However, all breeds and disciplines do allow protective headgear with no penalty and we urge their members to put safety ahead of tradition and adopt the new rule. Therefore, no helmets are mandatory as yet in Saddle Seat or Western classes but they are recommended. Approved headgear is mandatory in all over fence classes and Hunter Seat Equitation classes.

Farrier & Veterinarian Permit

No other Farrier or Veterinarian will be permitted to work on the grounds other than the official Farrier and official Show Veterinarian (on call) without registering with the Region 17 Show. Exhibitors wishing to use a Farrier or Veterinarian other than the official must have either one apply at the Show Office and pay a fee of \$100.00 before they can work on the grounds.

This will also apply to any Photographer who wishes to take photographs for a newspaper, TV, website, publication or sell their photographs at any time.

Late entries = those postmarked after June 28, 2010 will be accepted with a late jackpot premium fee of \$150.00, instead of the \$100.00 regular jackpot premium fee, until Wednesday, August 4, 2010 – 12:00 NOON)

Exhibitors will be required to pay **all class entry fees** to be entered in a Junior Horse Performance Jackpot class as with any other class in the show.

COUNTRY ENGLISH PLEASURE JUNIOR HORSE PERFORMANCE JACKPOT (Arabian & HA/AA)

Competitors enter the ring in a counter-clockwise direction, at the normal trot. Light contact must be maintained with all reins at all gaits. To be shown at a walk, normal trot, and canter. It is mandatory that horses be asked to halt on the rail, stand quietly, back, and walk off on a loose rein at least one direction of the ring. To be shown in a light show type bridle; either single curb or single snaffle curb and snaffle or Pelham bit. To be judged on attitude, manners, quality and performance, in that order. It is imperative that the horse give the distinct appearance of being a pleasure to ride. A quiet, responsive mouth is paramount.

HUNTER PLEASURE JUNIOR HORSE PERFORMANCE JACKPOT (Arabian & HA/AA)

Competitors enter the ring in a counter-clockwise direction, at the trot. To be shown at a walk, trot, canter and hand gallop both directions of the ring. To stand quietly and back readily. To be judged on quality, performance, suitability as a Hunter, manners and conformation. To be shown in a snaffle bit.

WESTERN PLEASURE JUNIOR HORSE PERFORMANCE JACKPOT (Arabian & HA/AA)

Competitors enter the ring in a counter-clockwise direction at the jog-trot. To be shown at a walk, jog-trot and lope. To be shown in a snaffle bit or hackamore. Must never have been shown in any Western event in a bridle. To be judged on substance, quality, performance and manners.

AWARDS: **Prize Payout** 100% of the nomination fee will make up the prize money payout - as follows.

Champion -	40%	Reserve Champion -	30%	
3rd Place -	10%	4th Place -	10%	5th Place - 10%

If there are fewer than 5 entries in any of the classes, money from the vacant placings will be divided equally among the class winners. Only horses shown and judged will receive prize money. 100% of the Class will be placed.

Top 5 placings will be presented in all Jackpot classes no matter how many have entered with 100% of the nomination fee being paid back, as indicated above, to all Top 5 placings. No trophy will be presented to Champion or Reserve Champion placings.
